Here's how to compose your Canadian song:

- Write one "Canada" word in each measure.
- Lightly pencil a rhythm to match each word *above the staff*. Use exactly 4 beats in each measure.
- Using the notes from D minor pentascale (D, E, F, G, A) make a melody to match your rhythm.
 - You must begin on D (tonic) or A (dominant) and end on D (tonic / home note)
 - You may write your melody only for the R.H. or share it between the R.H. and the L.H.
- Give your song a title and sign your masterpiece.
